#### Who can apply

Grade 11 and 12 students with a minimum of 16 credits

Returning to school full-time (secondary or post-secondary)

Attending a participating school from TDSB, TCDSB, PDSB (see meritaward.ca)

#### **Application Steps**

**CREATE** an account on the application website

#### **COMPLETE** the 3-part application

- 1. Secure academic references by March 23, 2026
- 2. Secure extracurricular references
- 3. Personal information

**SUBMIT** the application with references no later than March 26, 2026

#### Teacher Review Consists of:

- Completing the recommendation form on the SM Apply portal
- 2. Complete references by March 25

#### Admin Review Consists of:

- Uploading a student status sheet / student graduation summary
- Providing a student rating most deserving, very deserving, deserving, not nominated

- 4.Review submitted applications by March 30, 2026
